Addendum #2 to RFP Bid Conferences Feb. 22nd 2011

Alameda County Behavioral Health Care Services is releasing a second addendum to further clarify the interpretation of California Department of Mental Health policy of settling to cost for clinical services. With regard to this RFP, bids proposing that a sub-contractor provide any clinical services need to consider the following:

- The sub-contractor may not settle to cost for Medi-Cal.
- A sub-contractor that receives Medi-Cal revenue on a fee for service basis and does not settle to cost is eligible to be a subcontractor.
- The evaluation criteria set forth in the RFP states that “proposals that demonstrate realistic and achievable leveraging of additional funding streams will be ranked higher...”
