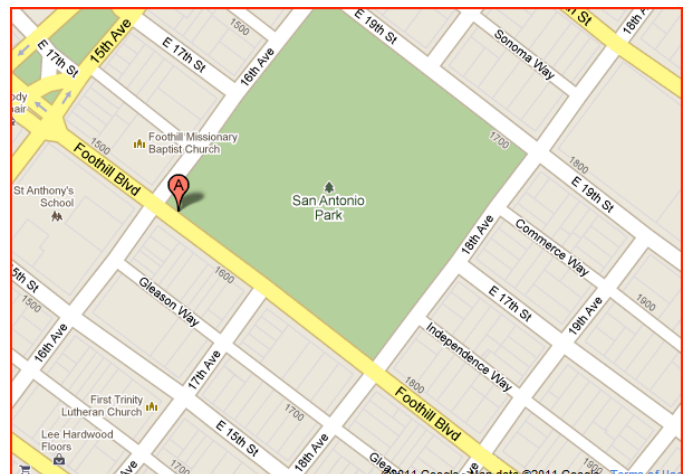
Come and enjoy food, games, wellness activities, cultural performances and honorary guest speakers. Families are encouraged to attend, and children are welcome!
